# CREDITON HAMLETS PARISH COUNCIL

May is a busy time for the Council with both the Annual Parish Council and Monthly Parish Council meetings falling in the month.

After 4 years Cllr Stevens has stood down as chair and is replaced by Cllr Parker with Cllr Price as vice-chair.

At the monthly council meeting a representative from Airband gave an illustrated presentation of the proposals for installation of full fibre broadband (speed up to 1000Mbps) within the parish which is contracted to be complete by end of September 2027. ### **A Trip to Trinity Church Yeoford**

At last a quiet Sunday at home so I headed down to the village to read the wildlife logbooks. At the church and the pub entries have not been numerous but with a rare sighting of snow buntings and the starlings murmuration tracked over the parish, exciting.

Adrian's entry from East Binneford was lovely. A description of the return of owls, house martins and butterflies in late April. Inspired, I left a description of weather and wild happenings at my place in mid May.

It would really help to build a picture of the wildlife in our parish by leaving a description of a day or week or month on the wildlife at your place. The wildlife log books are on the desk in Trinity Church Yeoford and in the back bar of The Duck to the right by the crisps.

I left the church, in the porch, house martins are nesting. On the lawn to the right as you leave, late orchids are emerging. The tall hedges are busy with birds. At the back beyond a sea of wildflowers there's a grove of oaks, branches left to grow to the ground. The smell of dark dampness, the banks covered in harts tail ferns, glossy and fresh, a pile of twiggy stems left to bring life anew.

In this tiny corner of Yeoford the wild is truly welcomed and cherished and I leave with a happy heart.
